NORTHFIELD LABOR DAY PARADE GUIDELINES

Please read our guidelines carefully as they are strictly enforced.

- You will receive confirmation of your parade entry by phone or e-mail.
- Floats will be judged prior to the parade and winners will be announced as they pass the reviewing stand.
- Please follow instructions from parade officials wearing official shirts, both in the assembly area and on the parade route.
- Do not stop in front of the reviewing stand unless you are asked to do so.
- No politicians are allowed to participate in the parade.
- No candidate for public office or holder of public office or their representatives may participate in the parade as a candidate.
- Participants may display the name of the organization only.
- Do not hand out advertising literature.
- All animal owners will be responsible for the removal and proper disposal of animal waste throughout the parade.
- No throwing candy or other items into the crowd, for the safety of the children.
- The parade ends at Kenyon's True Value. You may exit to North Main Street or return to the Crescent.
